

## STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS ON BROWSING THE HOMEPORT FOR TRAININGS:

<u>STEP ONE</u>: Go to <a href="http://homeport.seacadets.org/secure/TrainingList.aspx">http://homeport.seacadets.org/secure/TrainingList.aspx</a> to see the complete list of trainings. For summer, these are typically posted between March 1 – April 1. For winter trainings, they will typically post between Sept 1 – Oct 1. Once there, you have several ways to browse:



STEP TWO: Each of the blue topics indicate training categories. New recruits will find Recruit Training under "Navy Shore" or you can search by Recruit Trainings at the top. Once you open the category, you will see all the trainings listed under that category. Advanced Trainings (for those who have completed RT) are listed in all of the categories and carry their own pre-requisites and requirements. For example, the NSWOC SEAL training has a minimum age requirement and Basic Seaman under "Seamanship" requires that the Cadet have completed the Airman/Seaman coursework.



STEP THREE: If you select the "Details" link for each training, it will open up and give you information like the number of slots available for those attending the training (by gender) as well as the number of Staff Cadets positions available (for Petty Officers in their leadership development and advancement requirements). Often the training will have a website or facebook page with more information and that will serve during the duration of the training as a communication tool for parents and cadets.

After you have reviewed the details and pre-requisites and selected a training you would like to attend, you must fill out the online Request for Training on the FDR Sea Cadets website. <a href="https://www.fdrseacadets.org/trainings">https://www.fdrseacadets.org/trainings</a>. DO NOT DIRECTLY CONTACT ANY TRAININGS – YOU MUST REGISTER THROUGH YOUR OWN UNIT.
