## **Appearance/Uniform of the Day (UOD)**

Grooming Standards:

Males must have proper haircuts and clean-shaven face when reporting in for drill.

Females-proper hair/nail style and hair/nail color, no unnatural hair/nail color, when reporting in for drill.

**Attendance is Mandatory** - You must attend 75% of all scheduled drills to remain a member of this unit.

## Sea Bag List

- **Sea Cadet ID:** If your ID has expired, or you have not received your ID card, info the cadet command.
- **Boot/Shoe Shining Kit;** Recommended Kit: Black Shoe Polish, Shine Brush, and White-Tee Shirt  
Please research "Shoe Shine Kit" for general options or cadets can reach out to their staff cadets.
- Grooming
- **Bring personal chow** [no refrigeration/microwave accommodation available]
- All cadets to be in Dress White Uniform are expected to have uniform in full regulations:
  - ✓ Hat, White
  - ✓ Dress White Jumper and Trousers with NSCC Shoulder Flashes
  - ✓ White Crew Neck Undershirt
  - ✓ Neckerchief, Ribbons, and Nameplate
  - ✓ Dress White Belt with silver belt buckle
  - ✓ Black Shoes (SHINED) with black socks
- Cadets that are not able to be in Dress Whites full regulations will wear PTU's:  
Extra Set of PT Gear: NSCC PT Shirt or Yellow Shirt (if cadet did not buy additional PT Shirt), NSCCPT Shorts or Navy Blue Shorts (if cadet did not buy additional PT Shorts), Underwear, and White Socks
